

## EXPLANATION OF FEES

---

### **Educational Services Fee**

The Educational Services Fee supports general *instructional* operations and academic equipment needs of undergraduate and graduate programs. In addition, the fee revenue may be used to cover costs incurred in delivering certain courses such as instruments, instructional equipment, required course/university tests and examinations, laboratory supplies, course-required field trips, student teaching, clinical experiences, or related activities.

### **Student Services Fee – Effective Fall 2016**

The Student Services fee helps to cover the expenses of *non-instructional* student support services provided to graduate and undergraduate students of the University. It defrays the expenses of a broad range of student support services, including but not limited to enrollment services, support of the co-curricular programs and activities not covered by other fees, career services, trolley operations and the University Health Center. A higher fee is charged for courses offered at the main campus to cover expenses associated with services provided there, such as the student trolley and student health center.

### **Student Activity Fee**

The Student Activity Fee is charged on behalf of the Student Auxiliary Services, Inc., and it generates funds for student activities, intercollegiate athletics, social functions, dances, movies, concerts, art and lecture series, cultural events, the student newspaper, and programming at the Parsons Union Building. The fee also supports programming initiatives for distance education students, including YMCA and fitness memberships, movie passes, etc.

### **Student Facilities Fee**

The Student Facilities Fee covers the costs of operating and maintaining auxiliary student facilities, such as the Parsons Union Building and the Student Recreation Center. Such costs include facilities upkeep and renovation, utilities and custodial costs, debt service, and staffing.

### **Technology Tuition Fee**

The Technology Tuition Fee helps to defray the costs of rendering technology resources and services to enhance student learning experiences.

### **Nursing Fee**

The Nursing fee is charged on courses offered in the Associate of Science, Nursing program and helps to cover instructional services in this high-cost program.

### **ClinicalKey Fee- Effective Fall 2016**

The ClinicalKey Fee is charged to all students in the Master of Science, Physician Assistant program. It covers the cost of providing access to an online tool that operates as a clinical search engine.
