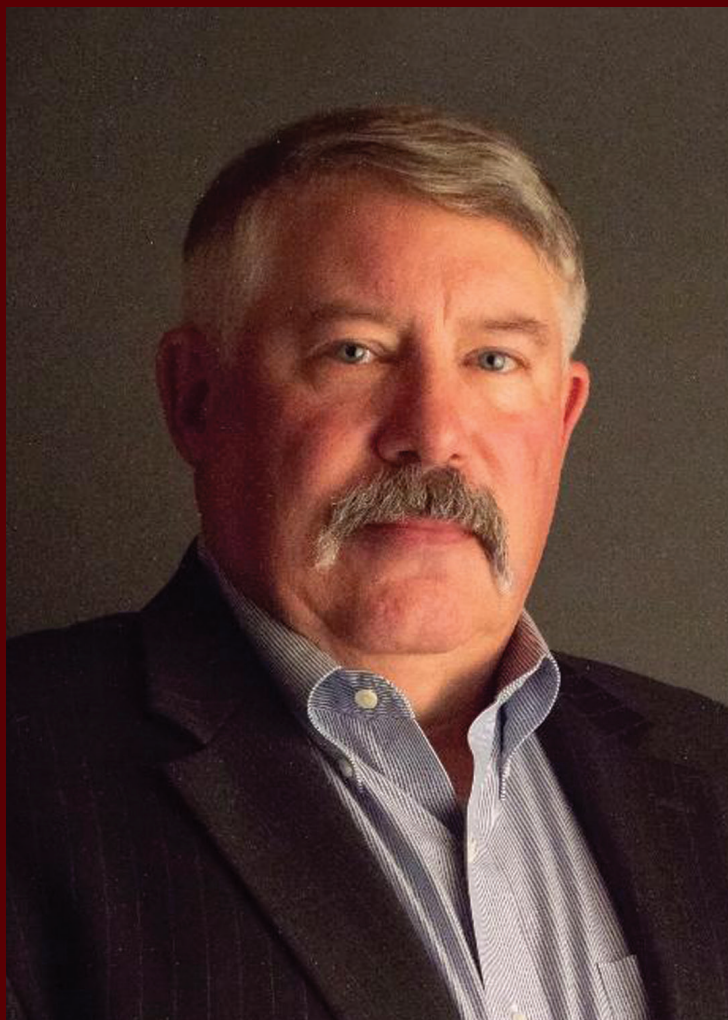


# John T. Yonkin, '81

## Retired Chief Executive Officer, Immunetics, Inc.

- Served as the Chief Executive Officer for the biotechnology company, Immunetics, Inc., with responsibilities for strategic and tactical operations. Under his leadership, the company commercialized the BacTx bacterial detection system, underwent a turnaround moving to profitability, and was successfully sold in 2017. He still advises several medical diagnostic companies and provides angel funding for start-ups in the Boston area.
- Held other executive roles in the medical diagnostic device market including President of Inverness Medical Nutritionals Group; President of Biosite; and Corporate Vice President of Strategic Projects, Corporate Vice President of Worldwide Operations, and President of North America for Alere, Inc., a global leader in point-of-care diagnostics manufacturing and distribution.
- Was commissioned as a 2LT in the U.S. Army following his ROTC detachment at LHU, served five years as a Regular Army Officer branched in the Air Defense Artillery, and later served five years in the U.S. Army Reserve.
- Has volunteered as a firefighter for nearly 45 years and was awarded the Medal of Valor for his actions in rescuing a homeowner during a fire. He also is a certified flight instructor and certified commercial drone pilot.
